

TERMS OF USE – FREE FLOW ON AUTOMATIC TOLL LANES

All free flow lanes (fast ETC) users on automatic lanes are obliged to follow the indicated instructions in order to drive through the lanes quickly and safely so as not to endanger themselves or other motorway users:

- 1. ETC device has to be installed in accordance with the instructions received upon purchase.**
This means that the ETC device for the I category of vehicles has to be fastened in the centre of the inner side of the windscreen, up to 7 cm from the top of the windscreen in the area with a tinted sun strip. **It is very important to place the entire device within the tinted sun strip.**
2. Prescribed safety distance between your vehicle and the one in front of you, which is using the same free flow lane, should always be kept. **Safety distance is at least 20 meters.**
3. It is required to comply with the speed limits indicated on the traffic signs and carriageway markings which apply to free flow. The vehicles which are using the free flow lanes are not allowed to drive faster than **40 km/h.**
4. Free flow lane is intended solely for the I category of vehicles.

In case you do not follow the instructions and obey the specified rules for free flow lanes, problems might occur, and they might have an effect on road users' safety, produce unnecessary traffic jams, traffic diversion to service lanes and paying toll with other methods of payment.
